MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE

CHAPTER 131

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO MUNICIPAL COMPOSTING PROGRAM

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Haverhill that the Code of the City of Haverhill, Chapter 131, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

§131-2 Fees.

B. By adding the words "- screened; \$6 per cubic yard - unscreened" after the word "yard", and

By adding the following at the end of subsection B:

"(3) \$3.75 per cubic yard unscreened for those persons purchasing more than 200 cubic yards per year."

Chapter 131: COMPOSTING PROGRAM, MUNICIPAL

[HISTORY: Adopted by the City Council of the City of Haverhill 8-10-2004 by Doc. 57-B (Ch. 131 of the 1980 Code). Amendments noted where applicable.]

GENERAL REFERENCES

Hazardous waste facilities— See Ch. 163.

Littering — See Ch. 173.

§ 131-1. Establishment; purpose.

There is hereby established a Municipal Composting Program, hereinafter called the "Program," which shall provide for the disposal of brush, grass and leaves. The Program shall be operated by the Highway Department at a location and at hours to be designated by the Superintendent of Highways.

§ 131-2. Fees.

A. Fees for the disposal of brush, grass and leaves shall be as follows:

- (1) Individual residents: \$35 annually (with sticker) or \$7 per day; \$10 annually for a second sticker within the same household; all with proof of residency. **[Amended 5-10-2005 by Doc. 59]**
- (2) Senior residents (age 65 or older): \$25 annually (with sticker) or \$7 per day; \$10 annually for a second sticker within the same household; all with proof of residency. **[Amended 5-10-2005 by Doc. 59]**
- (3) Commercial and nonresident: \$35 per cubic yard.

B. Fees for the purchase of compost shall be as follows:

- (1) All persons: \$15¹⁰ per cubic yard.
- (2) Delivery charge: \$35.

§ 131-3. Sale of other materials. **[Added 7-10-2007 by Doc. 76]**

The Highway Department is authorized to sell the following materials to the public:

- A. T-Base (road grinding by-product): \$9 per yard (screened) and \$5 per yard (unscreened).
- B. H-Base (recycled gravel): \$6 per yard.
