MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE

CHAPTER 240





§ 240-98. Schedule P: Heavy Commercial Vehicles.

In accordance with the provisions of § 240-57, the use and operation of heavy commercial vehicles is restricted on the following streets or parts thereof:

Name of Street Limits/Restrictions

Adams Street
[Added 7-28-1998 by Doc. 69-H]
 From Lincoln Avenue to Brown Street. Exempted from this entry shall be emergency vehicles and vehicles used in connection with the construction, maintenance and repair of said streets or public utilities therein, and any local, state, federal or public service owned vehicles.

Allen Street
[Added 7-9-2002 by Doc. 112-F]
 From the intersection of South Main Street to the intersection of South Elm Street. Exempted from this entry shall be emergency vehicles and vehicles used in connection with the construction, maintenance and repair of said streets or public utilities therein, and any local, state, federal, or public service owned vehicles.

All streets in each residential zoning district, as shown on the Zoning District Boundary Map of the City of Haverhill
[Added 8-9-1983 by Doc. 26-L; amended 3-28-1995 by Doc. 24-G]
 No parking of commercial trucks/vehicles 24 feet or greater in length and weighing 3 tons or more. Emergency vehicles are exempt.

Altamont Street
[Added 5-12-1998 by Doc. 69-C]
 The entire length of Altamont Street. The use and operation of heavy trucks having a capacity of over 20 tons or greater is restricted within the limits noted above. Exempted from this entry shall be emergency vehicles and vehicles used in connection with the construction, maintenance and repair of said streets or public utilities therein, and any local, state, federal or public service owned vehicles.

Alvanos Drive
[Added 5-19-1998 by Doc. 69-E]
 The entire length of Alvanos Drive. The use and operation of heavy trucks having a capacity of over 20 tons or greater is restricted within the limits noted above. Exempted from this entry shall be emergency vehicles and vehicles used in connection with the construction, maintenance and repair of said streets or public utilities therein, and any local, state, federal or public service owned vehicles.

Audubon Road
[Added 10-15-1991 by Doc.]
 Entire length between Middle Road and Amesbury Road (Route 110). The use and operation of heavy trucks having a capacity of over 2 1/2 tons or greater is restricted within the limits noted above. Heavy truck
